"We'll miss you!" Neku looked down with embarrassment. "And... please remember everything that happens here. You can tell us later! We'll go see Arseni and come back right away!"


The boy was going to travel so far from home for the first time and was obviously nervous. The friends fell silent. A car rumbled in the forest.



# WHAT IS THAT FIRE?

The east of Kamchatka is home to the largest population of Kamchatka foxes. Scientists have separated them into a separate subspecies.

lt's a Kamchatka fox running!



Like other foxes, Kamchatka foxes belong to the hound species. Similar to their distant 'relatives' (wolves, dogs and Arctic foxes), they are characterized by their elongated body, upright ears, dense fur and the shape of their paws. **Kamchatka foxes differ from other species in their bright red fur colour and larger skull size.** 





### WHAT DO THEY EAT?


Kamchatka foxes feed in a similar way to other foxes. They're predators. They like to eat rodents, hares, squirrels and birds. Kamchatka foxes also feed on salmon and other fish species. Kamchatka foxes often go to the seashore to feed on fish washed up by the sea.

### WHERE DO THEY LIVE?

It is easiest to see a Kamchatka fox in the Kronotsky Nature Reserve in winter. At this time of year, foxes prefer to hunt during the day using their sensitive sense of smell to find rodent burrows. The predator's bright red fur will be clearly visible on the snow, so you won't miss the famous Kamchatka fox.


In summer, it is much more difficult to see foxes in their natural habitat as they hunt at night.






